**PAYMENT PLANS** (the \$350 fee for Extended Healthcare Benefits is included in the first installment):

- I will apply for Government Student Aid\***. [Note: All supporting documents must be submitted no later than June 30/22. If you have applied for government student aid for Semesters 1-3, you will need to reapply for Semester 4.] I understand that I am responsible for paying any tuition fees not covered by this loan. I will pay the outstanding balance in full by November 1/22.
- I will pay the outstanding balance in 4 equal installments\*** of \$2,222 (\$2,597 for P/J–French) on August 1/22, and \$1,871 (\$2,245 for P/J–French) on September 1/22, October 1/22 and November 1/22.

**\*Outstanding balance is subject to monthly interest at 12% per annum**

**PAYMENT METHODS:**

- Online Payment through a Canadian financial institution** (*preferred payment method to keep Tyndale’s processing fee low*): Please add “Tyndale University” as a payee to your “bills” list. The account number will be your Student ID number. If your student ID is shorter than 9 digits, please add ‘000’ in front of your student ID number. ex. 000123456. Please note that online payments take 2 business days to reach our bank, please allow for sufficient processing time.
- Visa or MasterCard:** Please submit your payment at <https://pay.tyndale.ca>.
- Cheques:** Please send a cheque by mail or drop off a cheque at the campus Reception. (please make the cheque payable to “Tyndale”)

**ONLINE PAYMENTS****Which financial institutions can I make online payments from?**

You can pay for your tuition fees online if you bank with one of the following financial institutions: CIBC, TD Canada Trust, Bank of Montreal, Scotiabank, Royal Bank, HSBC, Simplii Financial or Tangerine.

**I am unable to register "Tyndale University" as the payee.**

Some banks do not have Tyndale registered with the exact name as the one mentioned above. Please search for "Tyndale" and our full name will show up.

**GOVERNMENT STUDENT AID (ex. OSAP)****I already applied for government student aid for Semesters 1-3, do I need to apply again for Semester 4?**

Yes, you will need to reapply and complete the 2022-2023 application to be eligible for government student aid for Semester 4.

**When will the government student aid applications be available?**

Government student aid applications for the 2022-2023 academic year will be available in Spring 2022.

**MISCELLANEOUS****Will I get a notification about the payment deadlines?**

Yes, you will receive a reminder in your MyTyndale email account approximately 2 weeks before the payment deadlines. These emails are sent as a courtesy and must not be relied upon. It is the responsibility of the student to adhere to the deadlines listed in this form.

**When can I expect my income tax receipt?**

Tuition tax receipts (T2202 & T4A) for the calendar years 2010-2021 are available through your MyTyndale account. 2022 tax receipts will be available on MyTyndale in February 2023.

**Will I receive a refund if I drop out of the program?**

The refund amount will be calculated for each course based on the percentage of completion and the approved withdrawal date.

Deadlines	Refund
Less than 20% of course duration	100%*
Less than 30% of course duration	80%**
Less than 40% of course duration	70%**
Less than 50% of course duration	60%**
50% of course duration	50%**
More than 50% of course duration	0%**

\* Drop Fee of \$100 per course will be charged.

\*\* Refund % applies to Tuition, Resource Fee, Student Activity Fee and Graduation Fee. Administration fee is not refundable.
