VALEDICTORIAN

Jonathan Fuller, Doctor of Ministry

Jonathan Fuller grew up in the Philippines where his parents served as missionaries with OMF International (formerly Overseas Missionary Fellowship). He and his wife Marilyn had the privilege of returning to the Philippines with OMF to live and serve in a Filipino Muslim community for many years. More recently, Jon has been based in Singapore as a mission leader, travelling frequently in Asia and globally.

Jon took up a new role as Resident Missiologist with the Evangelical Fellowship of Canada (EFC) in January 2023. As a missiologist, he spends time connecting to church, agency, academy and marketplace leaders around the intersection of church, gospel and culture.

He also serves as Executive Director for Our Common Calling, a partnership of the EFC, Lausanne Ministries Canada, the Canadian Centre for Christian Charities, and Christian Higher Education Canada.

His passion continues to be in investing in the next generation, helping them become everything God has called them to be.

Jon is the author of Cross Currents: The Story of the Muslim and Christian Encounter in the Philippines. The book combines historical research and personal stories while exploring the complex encounter between Islam and Christianity in the Philippines.

Jon earned an MA in Intercultural Studies from Fuller Seminary and a DMin in Leadership from Tyndale University.

VALEDICTORIAN

Chahe Bakmazjian, Master of Divinity

Chahe Bakmazjian was born in Beirut, Lebanon, and emigrated to Montréal at the age of six, during a civil war. He became a follower of Jesus in 1987 at the age of 17.

After graduating from Ecole Polytechnique with an undergraduate degree in Mechanical Engineering, he worked in robotics and engineering software for more than 20 years. In 2014, he sold his company to pursue a calling and prepare for Christian ministry.

Chahe has been an active member of First Armenian Evangelical Church in Montréal for more than 30 years. He is currently part of the church's pastoral ministry team, having formerly served in teen and youth ministry, worship leadership, teaching, pastoral counselling and being a board member.

He has also served as vice-president of the board of Emmanuel Christian School in Montréal.

Having completed an MDiv at Tyndale University in Pastoral Ministry, Chahe intends to serve in a greater capacity in his church as a teacher, leader and pastor. At the same time, he is open to other opportunities that the Lord may open up for him.

CONVOCATION SPEAKER

Bishop Jenny Andison

Bishop Jenny Andison was born in England and has lived in Pakistan, India, Singapore and Japan. She resides in Toronto, is married to Tim and they have three daughters, Emma, Kate and Charlotte.

Bishop Andison earned a BA (Hons.) from Queen's University in 1994 and received her Master of Divinity from the University of Toronto (Wycliffe College) in 1997.

Bishop Andison was ordained to the priesthood in 1998 and served as the Associate Vicar of St. James Clerkenwell, London U.K. (2001 -2005), she has also served in the Diocese of Tokyo and the Diocese of Ontario.

In the Diocese of Toronto, Bishop Andison served as associate priest for church development at St. Paul's, Bloor Street (2006 – 2013), the Archbishop's Officer for Mission (2010-2013) and incumbent of St. Clement, Eglington (2013-2016). She was elected bishop in September 2016 and consecrated in January 2017. In 2017, Wycliffe College honored Bishop Andison with a Doctor of Divinity (honoris causa).

In October 2020, Bishop Andison announced her intention to step down as bishop in early 2021 in order to resume parish ministry as the incumbent of St. Paul's Bloor Street Anglican Church; she retains the title of bishop.

HISTORY OF TYNDALE UNIVERSITY

Tyndale University was founded in 1894 as the Toronto Bible Training School. Later it changed its name to Toronto Bible College and in 1968 merged with the London College of Bible and Missions to become Ontario Bible College. The Seminary was established in 1976 to offer graduate theological education. In 1998, the name Tyndale was assumed, honouring William Tyndale (1494–1536), the early English reformer whose commitment to making Scripture available to all persons led him to undertake the first English translation of the Bible from original languages. He is a model for scholarship, faith, and vision.

In 2003, following a robust review by the Postsecondary Education Quality Assessment Board (PEQAB), Tyndale was granted university college status by the Province of Ontario. In 2007, Tyndale received approval from the Ontario Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities and from the Ontario College of Teachers to offer a Bachelor of Education program. The Seminary's graduate degrees, including the Doctor of Ministry degree, are accredited by The Commission on Accrediting of The Association of Theological Schools in the United States and Canada. In early 2020, following another review by PEQAB and their recommendation to the Ministry, Ministerial consent was granted to use the name Tyndale University. Tyndale's name was legally changed in December 2020 through an act of legislation to Tyndale University to clarify its standing as a postsecondary institution that focuses on high-quality academics and professional programs at the undergraduate, seminary and graduate levels.

Undergraduate level options include a BA, BBA, BRE, and BEd degree or a certificate in Christian Studies. Graduate level options include an MA, MTS, MDiv, DMin, post-DMin, or graduate diploma. Tyndale presently serves 1,600 students annually representing more than 40 denominations and 60 ethnic backgrounds. Today, Tyndale alumni are making a difference in the world and are working in private, public and not-for-profit sectors.
