Course Description

Assignments

1. Class Participation and Attendance – 8% (1% per class)
- This course encourages interaction and discussion within a learning community for mutual benefits. Students will discuss on the class materials in a small group. They are expected to attend all 8 classes. To complete this course successfully, participants must NOT miss more than 2 classes.
2. Insights from Class Materials – 42%

Group Presentation:

- 10-15 minutes max.
- Suggestions for implementing the assigned ministry
- Scenario:
 - Mid-size church (350 people in total):
 - 120 young couples
 - 40 young adults
 - 60 middle aged
 - 30 seniors
 - 30 youth (aged 12 – 18)
 - 60 children (aged 4-11)
 - 10 babies/ toddlers
 - Congregations:
 - 2 Worships (E+C)
 - 2 Sunday Schools (E+C)
 - Children Sunday School (4 classes) + Children Worship
 - CM Team:
 - 24 volunteers, monthly rotation
