I. COURSE DESCRIPTION 課程簡介

This course will give an overview of the message of Isaiah in light of the historical and literary setting of the book and the experience of Israel. Special emphasis will be placed on the call of the prophet, the messianic passages, the concept of the remnant, the servant songs, and the prophet's teaching on social justice. The message of the book will be studied with the goal to make the teachings of Isaiah applicable to the life of the church today.

Specific Guidelines for Assignments

1. Isaiah Outline (30%)

Due: Jan 19-Feb 16, 2024

讀書札記

One of the main assignments of this course is the reading assignments. You will be assigned readings from the book of Isaiah as well as from the textbooks and other articles.

Students are required to read through the book of Isaiah and write an outline for each section (Isa 1-12; 13-27; 28-39; 40-55; 56-66). When writing an outline to a certain section in Isaiah, read the assigned chapters thoroughly in one setting. Demarcate the main sections and subsections by noticing the change of scenes, subject matters, characters, themes, and etc. Give descriptive title for each section. Cite verses for each section and use point form only. The purpose of this assignment is to familiarize you to the events and the prophetic messages in the book of Isaiah and to know the structure of the book (total mark for this part is **30%)**.

Comparative Book Review (20%)

Due: Feb 23, 2024

After you have done the outline for each section, read through the corresponding sections in the two textbooks and compare the two commentaries, note their strengths and weaknesses. Write a four-page (2000 words) comparative book review at the end. When writing a comparative book review, first give a brief description of each book, then note their strengths and weaknesses, and finally give your assessment on each book (this part worth 20% of your final grade).

2. Seminar Discussion Group (10%) 小組討論一次

3. Research Paper (40%) Due: Mar 8, 2024
