I. COURSE DESCRIPTION

This is an introductory course to the exegesis of the Greek New Testament. Built upon Elementary Greek I & II, this course will further develop skills in reading, translating, and interpreting the Greek text for preaching and teaching through studying selected sections of 1 Corinthians.

II. LEARNING OUTCOMES

- 1/ To acquire a basic vocabulary of the Greek New Testament.
- 2/ To be able to read and translate Greek New Testament passages with the aid of a dictionary.
- 3/ To gain knowledge on basic NT Greek grammar for the purpose of exegesis.
- 4/ To study the message and theology of 1 Corinthians, and develop a methodology for and understand the process of Greek exegesis.

C. ASSIGNMENTS AND GRADING

1/ Test (30%)

Based on the assigned passages from 1 Corinthians and John's gospel. Includes translation and parsing.

2/ Assignment (30%)

Consists of questions related to Greek grammar and interpretation.

3/ Term Paper (40%)

An exegetical paper based on John's Gospel or 1 Corinthians. The student is expected to demonstrate sound knowledge of NT Greek and competence in Greek exegesis.

Assignments are due on the dates indicated. Extensions may be granted only at the discretion of the instructor. Late assignment will be penalized according to Tyndale policy. Plagiarism will not be tolerated.
