I. COURSE DESCRIPTION 課程簡介

Paul's Letter to the Romans is the greatest single exposition of Christian faith and mission ever written. Perhaps more than any other book of the Bible, Romans has been at the heart of Christian theology and has served as a catalyst for spiritual revival and reformation throughout the history of the Church. Moreover, the book of Romans has inspired such figures as Augustine, Luther, and Barth to reexamine their personal faith as well as the faith of the church as a whole. Consequently, this book is most valuable for in depth study and faithful teaching. Needless to say, the message written by Paul so long ago continues to speak to the hearts of believers throughout generations. This course is an interpretive (exegetical, structural, social, theological and pastoral) study of Paul's letters to the Roman believers. The students will go through a detailed exposition with its contemporary application and missional motifs. Course readings will be coordinated with the weekly lectures and specially assigned topics for debates and discussions.

此科研讀方式採取以註釋,題材,文化,神學,教牧等角度來明白保羅致信徒的書信之精華. 課堂講義注重歸納法解經及當代應用,特別是宣教的主題.閱讀內容將與每週講課及特別 有爭議性主題的討論配合指定.

- 5. an appreciation of Paul's heart for mission.
- 6. an appreciation the book's position in the New Testament, as well as in the Bible as a whole.
- 7. acquired the skill to accurately and appropriate application of the new insights, faith lessons and didactic teachings of Romans to one's life and, in turn, be able to confidently teach them to others in ministry.

 - a. A title page
 - b. A table of contents
 - c. An introduction
 - d. A thesis statement
 - e. The body should be a well-reasoned presentation of the subject, with solid exegetical support for your position.
 - f. A conclusion, containing a summary of the paper's contents
 - g. Footnotes
 - h. A bibliography of at least 8 sources consulted
