I. COURSE DESCRIPTION 課程簡介

This course seeks to understand the basic principles underlying the operation of small groups and how small groups can promote healthy church growth. We will examine the biblical basis of the small group structure and function in today's church. Discussion will be focused on group dynamics, friendship evangelism, spiritual direction, and small group leader's training.

II. LEARNING OUTCOMES 課程目的

At the end of the course, students will be able to:

- 1. Examine and evaluate the basic principles of small group function and operation.
- 2. Design, prepare and lead small groups in most church settings.
- 3. Apply the caring principles to nurture holistic growth of group members.
- 4. Analyze and critique the relationship between small groups and church growth, especially in areas of pastoral care, group leader's training, and supervision.
- 5. Co-author a training manual for small group leaders.

1. Book Report/Personal Reflection Paper 閱讀和個人反思報告- 30%

Write **TWO** book reports on (1) Donahue (textbook 1) **OR** Setiawani (textbook 2) and (2) Liang (textbook 3). The report should briefly summarize the key content of the book and then focus on your own take and application of the basic principles outlined in the book. ~2000 words for each report. (Related to Outcome #1)

撰寫**兩篇**閱讀報告: (1) 《小組全攻略》**或**《動力小組面面觀》, (2) 《督導:教會優 質增長的鑰匙》。報告包括書本主要內容的撮要和提供的小組原則, 焦點是個人的反思與 心得, 並如何實踐其中的原則。每篇約 2000 字。(學習成果#1)

2. Critique of small group ministry in local church 分析評估教會的小組事工-20%

Each learner will attend at least 3 different small groups of his/her church and assess the strengths and weaknesses of the small group ministry through personal observations, conversations, anonymous questionnaires, brochures, posters, growth statistics, etc. The learner should identify the key elements needed for the healthy growth of small groups. Learners should interact with textbooks and classroom material and propose practical steps that may promote healthy growth. 3000-3500 words + figures. (Related to Outcome #4.)

學員需要在自己所屬教會參加最少三個不同小組的聚會,透過個人觀察、交流、不记名问卷、教會刊物、海報、增長數據等,分析並評估教會小組的現況,及其優點與弱項。學員需要與課本及授課的內容互動,提供解決攔阻教會健康成長的具體方案。全文 3000-3500字。(歡迎內加插圖)(學習成果#4)

3. Group project: Prepare and Lead small groups 4 times 四人小組作業:預備並帶領四次 小組 – 20%

This project contains three components, each constituting 10% of the marks. (1) Learners will divide into groups of four and engage in the study of either *Ruth* or *Jonah*. Each group will prepare material for 4 small group meetings based on the assigned book. (2) The *Ruth* group will send one member to lead the *Jonah* group each week, and vice versa. In this way, each member would have the opportunity to lead once and participate in 4 small group meetings. Feedback will be collected after each meeting and shared for future implementation. (3) Each group will summarize their experience and explain how they have improved over time. Group submissions should include (1) inductive study chart for each chapter of the assigned book, chart showing the flow of each small group meeting, (2) summary of the evaluation and feedback from group members after each meeting, and (3) overall learning experience. ~3000 words + 8 charts. (Related to Outcome #2, 3)

本作業包括三個部分(每部分佔分數 10%): (1)學員分 4 人小組,使用歸納法研讀*路 得記或約拿書*,然後預備帶領四次小組的材料。(2)跟著路得組每週派一位組員帶領約 拿組的成員以小組形式讀路得記,反之亦然;如此每個組員都有機會帶領一次小組並參加 小組四次。(3)每次小組聚會後組長必須收集回饋並評估並給自己組員分享,以謀求改 進。每組作業包括: (1)書卷每章的歸納法研讀圖表,並預備小組流程的圖表; (2) 撮要每次小組後收集的回饋和需要改進的地方; (3)對整體學習經驗的反省。約 3000 字,另加 8 個圖表。(學習成果#2,3)

4. Group project: Develop training sessions for small group leaders 小組作業: 培訓小組組 長的計劃與課程 – 30%

Each group will share their assignment 2 and decide on a topic for group leader training. You can choose from one of the following topics: pastoral care, friendship evangelism, group spiritual direction. Other topics should receive prior approval from the instructor. The training should take the format of 4-6 small group meetings. The group submission should include (1) rationale, (2) resources, (3) objective and planning chart for each training session, (4) follow-up and evaluation method, (5) plan for implementation. 2500-3000 words, plus charts and figures. (Related to Outcome #5)

本作業由小組合作完成,各小組成員彼此分享作業2的心得,制定策劃一個培訓小組組 長的課程,課程的主題可以選自以下的題目: 關顧牧養,友誼佈道,小組靈命導引,其他 題目必須事先獲得講師同意。培訓計劃以4-6次的小組模式進行。每組作業內容應包括: (1)培訓的緣由,(2)資源,(3)整體的目標,每節的目標,策劃每次小組培訓的流 程表,(4)跟進與評估,(5)實踐計劃。2500-3000字,附加每節培訓的流程表,及其 他圖表。(學習成果#5)

E. EQUITY OF ACCESS
