I. COURSE DESCRIPTION 課程介紹

This course is an introduction to the systematic study of Christian doctrines according to the Evangelical tradition. Historical (diachronical) and thematic (synchronical) aspects are explored in each major Christian doctrine. The learning outcomes of this course are in line with the learning outcome of the M.Div. Program which is to train pastors and missionaries for the Chinese Church. Hence, special emphasis is placed on the application of these doctrines in evangelism, apologetics, pastoral ministries, missiological considerations and theological contextualization. Class discussions and assignments are designed to encourage the students to apply the contents of the course in these related fields.

II. LEARNING OUTCOMES 學習成果

At the end of the course, 讀畢本科:

- 1. Learning Outcomes in the Cognitive Domain: 認知目的
 - 1.1. Students will develop a comprehensive and in-depth understanding and appreciation of the Christian Doctrines of Christology, Hamartiology, Pneumatology, Soteriology, Ecclesiology and Eschatology.

- 1.2. Students will be able to apply the understanding of Christian doctrines to pastoral ministries in preaching, counseling, teaching and writing.

- 1.3. Students will learn to analyze and synthesize the knowledge of these doctrines in the context of evangelism and the defense of Christian faith.

1.4. Students will gain insights and evaluate various missiological issues in the Missions field.

 - 2.2. Students will organize and develop their own theological system and positions on various issues.

D. ASSIGNMENTS AND GRADING 作業及評核

1. Class Participation: Attendance, Discussion, Assigned Readings (10%)

The students are required to read the assigned texts and class notes according to the class schedule and prepare to interact in class with other student.

2. Critical reflection on the reading materials.

(40%)

Read through the assigned reading materials and write up 4 critical reflections 3-page single space each (10% each) on a certain theme of the reading materials. This assignment develops the Learning Outcome 1.1 concerning the development of the student's cognitive understanding about formulizing a consistent system of theology.

3. Final Paper: 15-page paper on an issue of a selected doctrine

(50%)

This assignment encourages the student to do a scholarly research on a specific issue of the student's choice on a certain doctrine. It could be a study of a theologian, or exegesis of the scripture, or certain aspects of a doctrine. This assignment develops the Learning Outcome 1 and 2 to measure the student's ability to apply the understanding of Christian Doctrine in the development of personal theological position and apologetic defense of Christian Faith.

此作業鼓勵學員進行一項學術的寫作。學員可自選一個教義內的相關問題來討論, 其範圍可以是一個神學家、或一段神學性的經文、或一個教義的問題。此專文包含 首頁、導論、本論、結論,並有註腳列出引內著作的出處和專文後附有參考過的書 目。此作業針對課程目的 1 的認知目的和 2 的感知目的,測試學員應用基督教教 義於衛道護教的能力,以及讓學員發展個人神學立場。
